THE BASICS

The object of Double Draw Poker is to get two pair or better. You are competing against a payable, not against the dealer or other players. Double Draw Poker is played with a single 54-card deck. The two jokers can be used as aces or to complete a straight, flushes or straight flushes.

GETTING STARTED

Make equal bets on the ante and bonus. You will then receive five cards.

After looking at your cards, you have a choice: Fold or stay in the game by making a "draw" bet for an amount equal to your ante. If you make the draw bet, you may discard 0, 1, 2 or 3 cards. The dealer will give you an equal amount of replacement cards.

You then have another choice: Fold or stay in the game by making a second draw bet for an amount equal to your ante. If you make the draw bet, you may discard 0 or 1 card. The dealer will give you an equal amount of replacement cards.

WINNING & LOSING

You win if you end up with two pair or better. If you get two pair or better, your ante and draw bets pay even money and your bonus bet pays according to payable. See layout for odds.

HAND RANKINGS & PAYOUTS

Player Hand	Payout
5 Aces	500 to 1
Natural Royal Flush	100 to 1
Wild Royal Flush	50 to 1
Straight Flush	50 to 1
Four-of-a-Kind	20 to 1
Full House	5 to 1
Flush	3 to 1
Straight	2 to 1
Three-of-a-Kind	1 to 1
Two Pair	PUSH

Gratuities may be offered in return for providing great guest service. You can offer a gratuity by giving a chip to your dealer or server. You may also wager your chip on behalf of the dealer by placing it with any bet that you make for yourself.
