HOW TO PLAY ROULETTE











ROULETTE

THE BASICS

The Roulette Wheel has 36 numbers plus a "0" and "00". The numbers are alternately colored red and black, except for the zeros, which are green.

HOW TO WAGER & PLAY

Players place their bets on the layout on the numbers corresponding with the ones on the Roulette Wheel. Players can make a variety of wagers at the same time for a chance to win multiple payoffs.

A wager on a single number is called "straight up." A wager on two numbers is called a "split." It's a "street bet" for three numbers and a "corner" for four numbers.

The dealer then spins the wheel in one direction and the ball in the opposite direction. When the ball drops into the winning number slot and comes to rest, the dealer clears all the losing bets and pays all the winning bets.

Odd or Even	1 to 1
Red or Black	1 to 1

Gratuities may be offered in return for providing great guest service. You can offer a gratuity by giving a chip to your dealer or server. You may also wager your chip on behalf of the dealer by placing it with any bet that you make for yourself. Some restrictions apply.
